The history of Christianity is rich in sacrifice. Our spiritual heritage is replete with men and women who followed Christ, hungered to know Him, and gave their lives—through service and martyrdom—to make Him known.

In the book *Outsiders*, I told the stories of some of these heroes of the faith, including Bible translators John Wycliffe and William Tyndale; non-conformist preachers Hugh Latimer, Nicolas Ridley, and John Bunyan; hymn writers John Newton and William Cowper; missionaries William Carey and David Livingstone; and many others.

In May of 2024, Terrie and I will, for the first time, be hosting the “Outsiders Tour” through England to visit the places where these and other men and women whose faith and courage has changed history lived and served the Lord.

On this ten-day tour through Great Britain, we will visit the sites where our spiritual forebearers loved and served God, and we’ll learn the historic context in which they stood for Christ. We’ll see the locations and learn the history of our King James Bible, the martyrs for the gospel during the Reformation, and the many influences on our own faith.

I want to invite you to be a part of this amazing trip. My prayer is that you will come away enriched with a deeper understanding of the heritage of our faith and renewed in your own commitment and dedication to Christ.

DAYS 1-2, MAY 13-14: DEPART USA, ARRIVE IN LONDON

Our Outsiders adventure begins with an evening flight to London. Upon arrival in London on Tuesday, we will transfer to our hotel for a welcome dinner and orientation followed by a night of rest.



DAY 3, WEDNESDAY MAY 15: LONDON

On Wednesday, we will begin our first full day of sightseeing. Highlights will include a visit to Bunhill Fields, the burial grounds of non-conformists. These true “outsiders” took courageous stands for Christ. Graves include John Bunyan, Susanna Wesley, John Rippon, Isaac Watts, and others. Across the street, we’ll have the opportunity to tour John Wesley’s home and chapel.

Later on Wednesday, we’ll visit the Smithfield Martyrs’ Memorial which commemorates the price many paid for Christ. John Rodgers, editor of the Matthews Bible and the first English protestant to die under Bloody Queen Mary’s reign, was among those who were burned at the stake here. From Smithfield, we’ll visit St. Paul’s Cathedral—a landmark of London and the place where Bible translator John Wycliffe stood for trial.





DAY 4, THURSDAY MAY 16: LONDON

On Thursday, we'll visit the famous Tower of London and the church next to it, All Hallows by the Tower. As we tour the tower, we'll learn about the courageous stand people like Anne Askew took for Christ as they endured torture and martyrdom without denying their faith.

From the Tower, we'll visit the Museum of the Book, which includes a wealth of Bible artifacts and early manuscripts and prints of European Bible translations, including original Wycliffe manuscripts and collections with Tyndale's work as well as a first edition 1611 King James Bible.



DAY 5, FRIDAY MAY 17: LONDON

Friday we begin another full day of touring London as we drive by Buckingham Palace and then visit Westminster Abbey for a guided tour. Of special significance here is the grave of David Livingstone, as well as various English royalty who had important roles in either persecuting non-conformists or contributing to the translation of the English Bible.

On Friday we will visit the secret underground war rooms that Winston Churchill used during World War II to ensure the uninterrupted carrying out of the allied mission.

Additionally, we will drive by the Lambeth Palace and see the adjoining tower, known as "Lollards Tower," because of the many Lollards (preachers trained by John Wycliffe) who were imprisoned and martyred here.

We'll end the day with an opportunity to go shopping at the famous Harrods of London—a huge department store covering five acres in central London.



DAY 6. SATURDAY MAY 18: LONDON

Saturday will be Spurgeon-themed day. We'll visit the Metropolitan Tabernacle where Spurgeon pastored as well as the West Norwood Cemetery where Charles and Susanna Spurgeon are buried. We will also see where Spurgeon trained nearly 900 pastors as preachers and soulwinners.



DAY 7, SUNDAY MAY 19: LONDON AND HAMPTON COURT

Sunday will include a visit to the world-renowned British Museum. Here you will see amazing artifacts, dating back as far as Abraham's time, that testify to biblical history and the preservation of God's Word.

Also on Sunday, we will visit Hampton Court Palace where King James I held a conference with non-conformists that ultimately led to the translation of the King James Version of the Bible.



DAY 8, MONDAY MAY 20: **OLNEY AND OXFORD**

On Monday, we depart London and drive to the quaint English town of Olney. Here we visit the church where John Newton pastored, tour the home and garden of abolitionist and hymn writer William Cowper, and visit the Sutcliff Baptist Church where missionary William Carey preached his first sermon.



DAY 9, TUESDAY MAY 21: **OXFORD**

Tuesday will be a rich day spent at Oxford, England. We'll visit the Angus library at the Regent's Park College that holds collections of letters and items belonging to William Carey and Charles Spurgeon.

In Oxford, we'll also visit Christ Church College where William Whittingham, who published the Geneva Bible, studied.

A highlight of the entire trip will be a visit to the Martyrs' Memorial in Oxford located at the very spot where Latimer, Ridley, and Cranmer were burned at the stake.



DAY 10, WEDNESDAY, MAY 22: OXFORD AND WINDSOR

Our final full day of touring will include a visit to the English town of Windsor. We'll see Windsor Castle and the attached St. George's Chapel. This chapel is not only where Queen Elizabeth II is buried and the location of many royal weddings, but it is also where William Latimer served for a time as chaplain.

From Windsor, we'll return to London for an evening dinner and time to share reflections from our trip.

DAY 11, THURSDAY MAY 23: DEPART LONDON HEATHROW

On Thursday morning, we'll transfer to the airport for the return flight home, inspired by the up-close encounters with men and women who took courageous stands for Christ and His Word.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$400.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1500.00 per person is due January 1, 2024. The final payment is due by March 10, 2024. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for an additional non-refundable fee of 3%. Reservations received after December 15, 2023 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per person up until 150 days before departure. For cancellations from 150-91 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$400.00 per person. Cancellations made between 90-61 days before departure will be subject to a 50% cancellatio fee. There will be no refund for cancellations within 60 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to TEMPLETON TOURS INC. in writing.

COVID PROTOCOLS: There are presently no COVID requirements for visiting England. Registered passengers will be notified of any changes to the COVID protocols.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip air transportation from Los Angeles, CA (LAX). Nine (9) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in four-star hotels. All meals as outlined in the brochure consisting of buffet breakfasts (B) and table d'hote dinners at the hotel (D). Sightseeing as outlined in the itinerary by private motorcoaches, utilizing the services of a local licensed speaking guide. Entrance fees for attractions if applicable. All transfers between airports and hotels by private motorcoach. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. All U.S. & UK departure taxes are included in the price of the tour. Tips to guides, motorcoach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are also included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: TTI strives to adhere to the printed itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes without advance notice during the tour. TTI reserves the right to change the itinerary, and is not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances beyond our control.

TOUR CANCELLATION: TTI reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by TTI, the sole and exclusive responsibility of TEMPLETON TOURS is to refund all monies recovered.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport costs, visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required). Lunches and food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not usually included with the table d'hote meals; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, room service orders, etc.; transportation between the home city and the international departure city.

AIR ROUTINGS: The price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45 day Apex fare to the London. TTI reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 60 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit of \$975 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify TTI in writing on or before December 15, 2023. Seat numbers will be assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Passengers are responsible for providing frequent flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are per person, based on two people sharing a room. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$1,395. (Tour participants without a roommate will have to pay single room surcharge.)

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One (1) piece of checked luggage whose overall dimensions do not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. One (1) piece of carry-on luggage & one personal item (i.e. purse, laptop bag, backpack). Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. Regulations are subject to change without notice. Please read the monthly correspondence from TEMPLETON TOURS for the most current information. Dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances are prohibited in your luggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the amount of walking at the sites we will visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. TEMPLETON TOURS, INC. reserves the right to refuse passage to anyone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond which we can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and many of the sites are not accessible by wheelchair.

INSURANCE: Acting only as agents for suppliers, TEMPLETON TOURS is not responsible for flight delays or missed connections, damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness and/or death as a result of any occurrences or conditions beyond its control, including, but not limited to, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, inclement weather, or theft. Your Name on the Registration Form must match your name as it appears on your Passport.

PRICE CHANGES: Tour conditions and air fares are subject to Governmental, IATA, ARC, and airline regulation requirements in effect at the date of and during the tour. All rates are quoted in US dollars and are subject to change without notice. Taxes and fuel surcharges are included in your tour cost and are subject to change without notice. Templeton Tours reserves the right to pass along fuel surcharges or additional taxes imposed by the airline.
