

October 18th - Departure from the USA for Dublin, Ireland

Set off on your unforgettable journey across the Atlantic towards Dublin, the capital of the Republic of Ireland. (Airfare is not included. Group airfare pricing will be offered at a later date.)

October 19th - Arrive in Dublin

Arrive in picturesque Dublin, located on Ireland's east coast at the mouth of the River Liffey. Transfer to hotel where your tour will begin with an orientation meeting with your Tour Manager, followed by a delicious welcome dinner and overnight in Dublin.

Meals: Dinner

October 20th - Dublin City Tour

A full day to discover spirited Dublin with its thousand-year history, immortalized by James Joyce. Visit Phoenix Park, one of Europe's largest walled city parks, home to the official residence of the President and the Dublin Zoo. Next visit St. Patrick's Cathedral, the National Cathedral of Ireland founded in 1191. On O'Connell Street, admire the handsome buildings that line the city's main thoroughfare. Lunch is provided at a local restaurant. In the afternoon visit Trinity College to see the celebrated Book of Kells, an illuminated manuscript created in the year 800 by Celtic monks. Tonight, enjoy an evening of dinner and music at a local venue. We overnight in Dublin.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner & Local Entertainment

October 21st - Dublin - Giants Causeway - Belfast

Depart Dublin and drive to the Giants Causeway. Local legend and romantic lore make visiting Ireland especially unique. At Giant's Causeway, you hear the "tale" of Finn McCool, the giant said to have created this geological wonder so he could walk to Scotland to confront another giant. Today, a massive floor of 38,000 hexagonal basalt columns stretches into the sea. We then continue to Belfast for dinner and overnight.

Meals: Breakfast, Boxed lunch, Dinner

October 22nd - Belfast, Titanic Experience Museum & Ulster Museum

Today tour Belfast, one of Europe's true renaissance cities. You'll see beautifully restored historic buildings, European-style cafes, and streets lined with vibrant murals. Tour the Titanic Experience, a fascinating nine gallery museum with multiple dimensional displays, special effects, reconstructions, and interactive features that explores the tale of the ill-fated ship. Lunch at a local restaurant. Then, drive by a neighborhood in West Belfast where buildings are still scarred from the days of "The Troubles," which ended with the 1998 Good Friday Agreement and continue past the university district, the Botanic Gardens and visit the Ulster Museum. We have dinner and overnight at a hotel in Belfast.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner













October 23rd - Ferry from Belfast to Cairnryan - Glasgow sightseeing

We begin the day with a transfer to the port to board a ferry to Cairnryan. Drive from Cairnryan to Glasgow. On arrival, meet local guide for tour and begin the exploration of Glasgow at George Square, named after King George III, boasting an impressive collection of statues and monuments, including those dedicated to Robert Burns, James Watt, Sir Robert Peel and Sir Walter Scott. Next we visit the imposing Glasgow Cathedral, a splendid example of 12th century Gothic architecture, dedicated to St. Mungo, the patron saint of the city. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Glasgow.

Meals: Boxed Breakfast, Boxed Lunch, Dinner October 24th – Glasgow - Loch Lomond - Glencoe - Aviemore

Depart Glasgow to "bonnie banks" of Loch Lomond, immortalized in song, the largest freshwater lake in the United Kingdom. A delightful cruise around the lake offers vistas of pretty villages, tranquil scenery and the Trossachs, Scotland's first National Park, an area commemorated in the writings of poet Sir Walter Scott. Lunch at a local restaurant by Loch Lomond. Continue to the Glencoe area with its glimmering lakes and sheltered forests and journey past Ben Nevis to Aviemore. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Aviemore.

Meals: Breakfast, lunch, Dinner

October 25th - Aviemore - Edinburgh

Depart Aviemore and drive to Edinburgh. Lunch at a local restaurant. After lunch a guided city tour of historic Edinburgh. The route will take you past the Scottish Parliament, Holyrood Palace, the Museum of Scotland, the Royal Mile, and Princes Street. Visit to Edinburgh Castle, where you can see the Crown Room, Royal Palace, and St. Margaret's Chapel, the oldest surviving building in Edinburgh. Dinner and overnight at hotel in Edinburgh.

October 26th - Edinburgh at Leisure

Today enjoy time to explore the quaint streets and charming cafes of Edinburgh. Tonight, farewell dinner and show. We overnight in Edinburgh.

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$400.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1500.00 per person is due May 11, 2026. The final payment is due July 6, 2026. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for a non-refundable fee of 3%. Reservations received after May 11, 2026 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per person up until 100 days before departure. For cancellations from 99 - 65 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50% of the tour price. There will be no refund for cancellations within 64 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to TEMPLETON TOURS INC. in writing.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Land only starting in Dublin, Ireland and ending in Edinburgh, Scotland. Eight (8) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in first class hotels. Ferry transfer from Belfast to Cairnryan. 22 Meals: consisting of 8 breakfasts, 6 lunches, and 8 table d'hote dinners (D). Sightseeing by private motorcoaches, utilizing the services of a local licensed English speaking guide. Entrance fees for select attractions. transfers between airports and hotels. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. Tips to guides, motorcoach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are also included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars based on double occupancy.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: TTI strives to adhere to the printed itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes without advance notice during the tour. TOUR CANCELLATION: TTI reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by TTI, the sole and exclusive responsibility of TEMPLETON TOURS is to refund all monies recovered.

NOT INCLUDED: Airfare, Passport costs, visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required). Lunches/dinners and food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not listed in the itinerary; optional sightseeing tours and excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, room service orders, etc.; transportation between the home city and the international departure city.

HOTELS: Tour prices are land only, per person, based on two people sharing a room. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$1595. (Tour participants without a roommate will be charged a single suppliment surcharge.)

CHANGE FEES: Changes to an existing reservation, whatever the cause, will incur a \$50 per person charge plus any additional supplier fees. This includes name spelling changes and rooming changes. Replacing a traveling passenger with another traveling passenger constitutes a cancellation, subject to cancellation penalties. Changes or additions after departure are subject to local rates at the time of amendment and must be paid directly by the passenger to the service provider. There are no refunds for unused services.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One (1) piece of checked luggage whose overall dimensions do not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. One (1) piece of carry-on luggage . Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. Regulations are subject to change without notice. Please read the monthly correspondence from TEMPLETON TOURS for the most current information. Dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances are prohibited in your luggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the amount of walking at the sites we will visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. TEMPLETON TOURS, INC. reserves the right to refuse passage to anyone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond which we can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and many of the sites are not accessible by wheelchair.
