Day 1 – Depart for Italy: *Our Italian Adventure Begins*

Today we board our international flight bound for Italy. As we cross the Atlantic, anticipation builds for the wonderful experiences ahead—romantic waterways, Renaissance masterpieces, medieval hill towns, magnificent churches, Tuscan countryside, and the timeless streets of Rome. Tomorrow, “*la bella Italia*” awaits!

Day 2 – Arrive in Venice: *Welcome to the Floating City*

Upon arrival, we'll transfer to our hotel in enchanting Venice, a city unlike any other in the world. Built across more than a hundred small islands and connected by hundreds of bridges, Venice seems almost to float upon the waters of its famous lagoon. The remainder of the day is yours to relax after our journey or begin discovering this magical city at your own pace. Wander beside a quiet canal, cross one of Venice's picturesque bridges, or simply find a café and enjoy your first taste of Italy. Tonight we'll enjoy dinner and settle in for our first overnight in Venice.

Overnight: Venice | Meals: Dinner

Day 3 – Murano & Venice: *Glass, Gondolas & the Grandeur of St. Mark's*

Our discovery of Venice begins on the water as we travel by boat to the island of Murano, internationally renowned for its beautiful handcrafted glass. During a visit to a local factory, we'll watch skilled artisans practice the centuries-old tradition of glassblowing, transforming molten glass into remarkable works of art. Then it's back to the main island for a guided walking tour through Venice's fascinating maze of narrow passageways, canals and bridges. Eventually the intimate streets open dramatically into magnificent St. Mark's Square, the ceremonial heart of Venice. Here we'll view the city's celebrated landmarks from the outside, including the pink marble Doge's Palace, the legendary Bridge of Sighs, and the magnificent Basilica of San Marco, whose golden details and distinctive architecture reflect centuries of Byzantine, Roman and Venetian influence. The remainder of the day is yours to explore. For a quintessential Venetian experience, you may choose the optional gondola ride and discover the city from the waterways that have served as its streets for generations.

Day 4 – Tuscany & Pisa: *Under the Tuscan Sun*

This morning we say “arrivederci” to Venice and journey south into one of Italy's most beautiful regions—the legendary countryside of Tuscany. Golden hills, vineyards, olive groves and picturesque farms create the landscape that has inspired artists and travelers for centuries. We'll stop at a local Tuscan farm for a tasting accompanied by delicious regional specialties, giving us an opportunity to experience the flavors and hospitality of rural Italy. Our journey continues to Pisa and the extraordinary Piazza dei Miracoli—the Square of Miracles. Here we'll view the Baptistery, Duomo, Monumental Cemetery and, of course, the world-famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Together these remarkable monuments create one of Europe's most recognizable architectural ensembles. Later we continue through the Tuscan countryside to Florence, birthplace of the Renaissance and home to some of the world's greatest artistic treasures.

Overnight: Florence | Meals: Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner

Day 5 – Florence: *Birthplace of the Renaissance*

Today we step into the extraordinary world of Renaissance Florence. Our guided walking tour takes us into the historic heart of the city, where magnificent architecture and priceless works of art seem to appear around every corner. We'll admire Florence's celebrated Duomo, crowned by Brunelleschi's revolutionary dome, along with Ghiberti's magnificent Gates of Paradise at the Baptistery and elegant Giotto's Bell Tower. Walking into Signoria Square feels like entering an open-air museum. Here we'll see the impressive Palazzo Vecchio, once home to the powerful Medici family and today the seat of Florence's city government. Our walk continues to the famous Ponte Vecchio, the beloved “Old Bridge” spanning the Arno River. Included tickets to the Accademia Gallery allow you to explore independently and discover one of Italy's most celebrated collections



of art. This afternoon is yours to enjoy Florence at leisure. Browse its wonderful shops, linger over a cappuccino, or simply wander streets once walked by Michelangelo, Leonardo and the great masters of the Renaissance. Tonight we'll venture into the beautiful Tuscan hills for dinner and entertainment—a delightful conclusion to our day in Florence.

Overnight: Florence | Meals: Breakfast

Day 6 – Assisi: *A Medieval City of Faith*

Leaving Florence this morning, we travel through the beautiful countryside of Umbria to Assisi, one of Italy's most treasured medieval towns. Perched high upon a hillside, Assisi's rugged stone streets, ancient buildings and sacred shrines provide an unforgettable setting for our walking tour. The city is best known as the birthplace of St. Francis of Assisi, whose life of humility, compassion and devotion has inspired Christians for more than eight centuries. At the heart of Assisi stands the magnificent 13th-century Basilica di San Francesco, one of medieval Europe's great artistic and spiritual treasures. Within the basilica are the sacred relics of St. Francis as well as extraordinary frescoes associated with Giotto. There is something deeply moving about walking these ancient streets and remembering a man who chose a life of simplicity and service. Following our visit, we continue south toward the Eternal City—Rome!

Overnight: Rome | Meals: Breakfast & Dinner

Day 7 – Vatican City: *Faith, Art & Michelangelo's Masterpiece*

Few places combine faith, history and artistic achievement quite like Vatican City. Today we'll explore the renowned Vatican Museums, home to one of the world's most important collections of art. As we make our way through magnificent galleries, we'll admire the Gallery of Tapestries and Gallery of Geographical Maps before arriving at one of the most anticipated moments of our journey—the Sistine Chapel. Here Michelangelo's breathtaking frescoes soar above us, representing one of the supreme artistic achievements of the Renaissance. We continue to St. Peter's Square, to view the exterior of St. Peter's Basilica, traditionally associated with the burial place of the Apostle Peter. The afternoon is yours to enjoy Rome at leisure. Those wishing to see even more may choose an optional walking tour featuring some of the Eternal City's celebrated piazzas and landmarks, including the Spanish Steps, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon and Piazza Navona. Tonight provides an opportunity to explore independently and discover a favorite neighborhood restaurant for an authentic taste of Roman cuisine.

Day 8 – Rome at Leisure: *Your Day in the Eternal City*

Today is yours! After several wonderful days of touring, enjoy the freedom to experience Rome exactly as you wish. Perhaps return to a favorite neighborhood, shop for those final Italian treasures, relax over a leisurely lunch, or simply find a sidewalk café and watch daily Roman life unfold around you. Sometimes the most memorable travel experiences occur when there is no schedule at all—and today provides the perfect opportunity to create your own Roman adventure. Tonight we'll gather for our Farewell Dinner, celebrating the wonderful experiences we've shared and the friendships we've made during our journey through Italy.

Day 9 – Depart Italy: *Arrivederci, Italia!*

Following breakfast, we transfer to the airport for our flight home. Our journey may be ending, but the memories will remain—the canals and bridges of Venice, Murano's artisans, Tuscany's golden hills, Pisa's famous tower, the masterpieces of Florence, the quiet faith of Assisi, and the magnificent treasures of Rome and Vatican City. We return home with photographs, new friendships and stories to share—but perhaps most importantly, with a deeper appreciation for the beauty, faith, art and history that have shaped this remarkable land. *Arrivederci, Italia!*—until we meet again!

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1500.00 per person is due December 2, 2026. The final payment is due January 27, 2027. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for a non-refundable fee of 3%. Reservations received after December 2, 2026 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per person up until 110 days before departure. For cancellations from 109 - 65 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50% of the tour price. There will be no refund for cancellations within 64 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to TEMPLETON TOURS INC. in writing. There are no refunds for unused services.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip Air Transportation from Nashville, TN (BNA). Seven (7) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in first class hotels. 12 Meals: consisting of 7 breakfasts, 1 lunch, and 4 table d'hôte dinners (D). Airport-hotel transfers in Venice & Rome for passengers flying on group flights. Sightseeing by private motorcoaches, utilizing the services of a local licensed English speaking guide. Entrance fees for select attractions. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. Tips to guides, motorcoach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are also included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars based on double occupancy.

AIR ROUTINGS: The price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45 day Apex fare to Europe. TTI reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit \$1,295 will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify TTI in writing on or before December 2, 2026. Seat numbers are assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Passengers are responsible for providing frequent flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are land only, per person, based on two people sharing a room. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$1595. (Tour participants without a roommate will be charged a single supplement surcharge.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One (1) piece of checked luggage whose overall dimensions do not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. One (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Tips to hotel porters are included

for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. Regulations are subject to change without notice. Please read the monthly correspondence from TEMPLETON TOURS for the most current information. Dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances are prohibited in your luggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the amount of walking at the sites we will visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour.
