The cruise begins as we depart Seattle, Washington on Monday and sail north to the untouched natural beauty of Alaska. Royal Caribbean's luxurious Quantum of the Seas will be your home for this 7-night Alaskan adventure, and Dr. Ralph Sexton & Pastor Trent McLaughlin will be your hosts during the cruise.

On Tuesday morning, we will start the day with a teaching service led by Dr. Sexton. The balance of the day will be spent sailing North to Alaska. While cruising, keep an eye out for wildlife sightings. Often spotted along this route are killer whales, eagles, and the majestic humpback whale.

Wednesday brings us to **Sitka, Alaska**. Like many communities in Alaska, Sitka is a town surrounded by wilderness. Experience the gorgeous coastal rainforest trails at Sitka National Historic park. While walking these trails, you will see a staple of the local Native American culture: the intricately carved totem poles. The Alaska Raptor center is another great visit. You can see various native birds of prey up close, such as eagles, owls, and hawks.

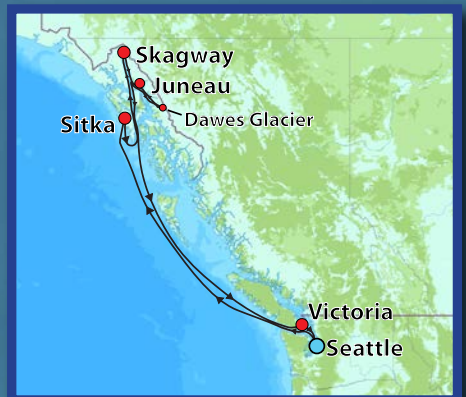
Thursday is a call at rustic **Skagway, Alaska**. Home to the White Pass and Yukon Route railroad, this northernmost port of the Inside Passage is best known as the beginning of the Chilkoot Trail, used by gold seekers in the late 1800's.

On Friday morning, we will sail by the picturesque **Endicott Arm & Dawes Glacier**. Once the captain has positioned the ship near the glacier, we will pause to view the magnificence of God's creation. In the afternoon, our ship will call on the capitol city of **Juneau, Alaska**, home to Mendenhall Glacier.

Saturday is a day at sea with fellowship, inspiring teaching, and a great time to enjoy the numerous amenities on the Quantum of the Seas as we head back south along the Alaskan coast.

Sunday we will dock in British Columbia's capital city, **Victoria**. This picturesque city has an intimate charm with a distinctly English flavor and is home to the world famous Butchart Gardens.

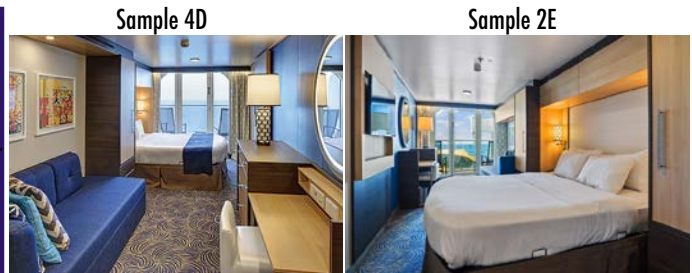
Our magnificent journey ends on Monday morning when our ship returns to Seattle, and we return with memories to cherish forever.

Pricing is based on two passengers sharing a cabin, each paying the full category price. All staterooms include a television, telephone, private bath, shower, vanity and hair-dryer. Most lower twin beds are convertible to a king-size bed. Pricing for 3rd and 4th passengers (regardless of age), sharing a cabin with two full-paying adults is available upon request. Single passengers requesting a private cabin will be charged 200% of the cruise price.

NOTE: Private Teaching Sessions and Reserved Dining for this group are only available to passengers who register through Templeton Tours.

General Conditions

Deposit Requirements: A deposit of \$300.00 (in US funds) is required to secure accommodations. Personal checks, money orders, and credit card (MC/Visa/Discover) payments are accepted. Deposits are accepted on a "first come" basis and availability is limited. The final balance is due by May 7, 2027. Deposits may be made by personal check, money order, or credit card (Visa/MC/Discover). Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for an additional 3% non-refundable fee.

Cancellations and Refunds: All cancellation requests must be addressed to Templeton Tours in writing. Cancellation fees will be charged as follows:

- \$125 per person when canceled more than 100 days before sailing.
- 50% of cruise fare when canceled 100-66 days of sailing.
- No refund for no-shows or when canceled within 65 days of sailing.

Airline ticket cancellation is subject to the cancellation policy of the specific airline. In most cases tickets are non-refundable. Trip cancellation insurance is recommended.

Identification: All U.S. passengers are required to present proof of citizenship in the form of a valid passport, or a certified birth certificate along with a government issued photo ID such as a driver's license. For more information or to obtain a passport application, visit www.travel.state.gov. Passengers denied boarding are not eligible for a refund. All non-U.S. Citizens should contact their respective embassies or U.S. & Canadian Immigrations for applicable regulations. Children under 18 years of age traveling without both parents must bring a notarized letter of consent from the absent parent(s), giving permission for them to leave the country with a specified adult guardian.

Embarkation: The Royal Caribbean Quantum of the Seas sails from Seattle, Washington at 4:00PM on Monday, August 9, 2027. Embarkation begins at 11:00AM. You must be on board no later than 2 hours before sailing.

Disembarkation: The Royal Caribbean Quantum of the Seas returns to Seattle, Washington at 6:00AM on Monday, August 16, 2025. Allow 1-2 hours for disembarkation, customs and immigration formalities.

Fare Inclusive: Your cruise rate includes ocean transportation, accommodations, entertainment, service and meals, and port charges. Prices are from Seattle, Washington in U.S. funds.

Accommodations: Prices are based on two full-paying passengers per cabin. Single cabins are available at 200% of the category price. Pricing for 3rd and 4th passengers in a cabin is available upon request.

Cruise Baggage Allowance: 2 medium suitcases, 1 carry-on bag per person.

Not Included: Air transportation and transfers to the port of departure, gratuities to ship employees, optional shore excursions, and items purchased onboard.

Disabilities/Pregnancy/Infants: Royal Caribbean Cruise Lines recommends that guests with disabilities complete a Special Requirements Information (SRI) form at the time of booking in order to prepare for the guests' arrival. Guests who are unable to care for their basic needs (e.g. dressing, eating, and attending safety drills) MUST have a capable traveling companion. Call Templeton Tours to request an SRI Form. RCCL will not accept reservations for infants less than 6 months of age on the date of sailing, or women who have begun their 24th week of pregnancy at any time before or during the cruise. Please notify us if you are pregnant.

Passage Contract: The attention of the passengers is specifically directed to the conditions of transportation set forth in the passage contract of the ticket of RCCL General Sales Agents and Operators. RCCL reserves the right to alter the itinerary or substitute vessels if deemed necessary.

Gratuities & Fuel Surcharges: All passengers will be charged gratuities regardless of age. Gratuities for your cabin steward, waiter, busboy, and Maitre d' (est. \$126.00 pp) will be added to your onboard account. Templeton Tours reserves the right to pass along any increase in fuel surcharges imposed by the cruise line.
