During this unforgettable journey through England, Belgium, and France, we'll walk the streets where Churchill inspired a nation, stand in the forests where American soldiers endured one of the war's fiercest battles, visit the beaches where freedom returned to Europe, and reflect upon the extraordinary price paid by those who fought for liberty. This is more than a sightseeing tour. It is an opportunity to stand where history happened—to honor the men and women of the Greatest Generation while gaining a deeper appreciation for the values they defended.

September 7th – Departure from the USA for London, England

Set off on your unforgettable journey across the Atlantic towards one of Europe's most famous cities.

September 8th – Arrival in London, “Their Finest Hour”

Our adventure begins in London, the city that refused to surrender. After arriving in England's historic capital, we'll settle into our hotel before enjoying an orientation walk through Westminster. As we stroll past Big Ben, Whitehall, and the center of British government, we'll begin to understand how Winston Churchill inspired an entire nation during its darkest days. This evening we gather for our Welcome Dinner, preparing for an unforgettable journey through the battlefields and memorials that shaped modern history. Dinner and overnight in London. (B/D)

September 9th - Wartime London

Today we explore the remarkable story of Britain's stand against Nazi Germany. Descending into the Churchill War Rooms, we'll see the underground command center where Churchill and his cabinet directed Britain's war effort during the Blitz. Here, history comes alive as we walk through the very rooms where some of the most important decisions of World War II were made. We continue to the Imperial War Museum, one of the world's premier collections dedicated to twentieth-century conflict, before stopping at the moving RAF Bomber Command Memorial honoring the airmen who risked—and often gave—their lives for freedom. Dinner and overnight in London. (B/D)

September 10th - Through the Channel Tunnel to Belgium

Leaving England behind, we board the Eurostar beneath the English Channel and arrive in Belgium, where Allied armies began the long push toward Germany. Our afternoon is spent exploring Antwerp, whose massive port became one of the Allies' most critical supply lifelines after its liberation. At the outstanding Museum aan de Stroom (MAS), we discover the city's wartime story while enjoying panoramic views over one of Europe's great historic ports. Dinner and overnight in Antwerp. (B/D)

September 11th - Bastogne: Courage in the Ardennes

Today we visit one of the most revered locations in American military history. At the Bastogne War Museum, immersive exhibits vividly tell the story of the Battle of the Bulge—the last major German offensive in Western Europe. Standing at the Mardasson Memorial, we remember the thousands of American soldiers who held their ground despite overwhelming odds. Our journey concludes in the forest of Bois Jacques, where the foxholes of Easy Company remain much as they were during the bitter winter of 1944. For many, this becomes one of the most moving experiences of the entire tour. Dinner and overnight in Liège. (B/D)



September 12th - Dunkirk: The Miracle of Deliverance

Crossing into northern France, we arrive in Dunkirk, where one of history's greatest military evacuations unfolded. At the Operation Dynamo Museum, we relive the dramatic rescue of more than 330,000 Allied soldiers whose escape allowed Britain to continue the fight against tyranny. Walking along the beaches where ordinary civilians and military vessels alike participated in this extraordinary effort, we gain a new appreciation for courage, determination, and providence. Dinner and overnight in Dunkirk. (B/D)



September 13th - Along the Channel Coast

Today's coastal drive follows the route of several important wartime events. In Calais we pause at the Green Jackets Memorial before continuing to Dieppe, site of the costly 1942 Allied raid that provided invaluable lessons later applied during the Normandy invasion. By evening we arrive in Le Havre, one of France's major ports and a city rebuilt after suffering extensive wartime destruction. Dinner and overnight in Le Havre. (B/D)



September 14th - Normandy: Where Freedom Returned

For many travelers, today becomes the emotional centerpiece of the journey. Standing atop the cliffs of Pointe du Hoc, we'll see where U.S. Army Rangers scaled sheer rock faces under intense enemy fire on D-Day. We continue to Omaha Beach, forever remembered as one of the most heroic battlefields in American history. At the Normandy American Cemetery, overlooking the beaches below, thousands of white crosses and Stars of David bear silent witness to the extraordinary sacrifice required to restore freedom to Europe. Time permitting, we also visit Utah Beach and remaining German bunkers along the Atlantic Wall, providing perspective from both sides of the battlefield. Dinner and overnight in Caen. (B/D)



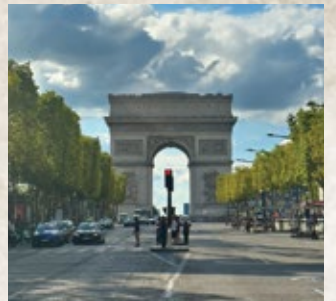
September 15th - Liberation of Paris

Traveling to France's beautiful capital, we discover another chapter in the story of liberation. Our guided tour includes the renowned Musée de l'Armée at Les Invalides before continuing through the streets where Parisians celebrated their liberation in August 1944. As we walk the city, our guide brings to life the stories of resistance fighters, Allied troops, and ordinary citizens whose courage changed history. Dinner and overnight in Paris. (B/D)



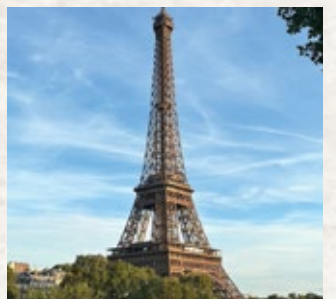
September 16th - Paris & The French Resistance

Our final full day focuses on the remarkable courage of the French Resistance. We begin at the Musée de la Libération de Paris, where powerful exhibits tell the story of resistance leaders Jean Moulin and countless ordinary citizens who risked everything to oppose Nazi occupation. Time permitting, we visit Mont Valérien, France's national memorial honoring members of the Resistance who gave their lives for freedom. The afternoon provides leisure time to enjoy the beauty of Paris before gathering one final time for a Farewell Dinner celebrating new friendships and an unforgettable journey through history. September 17th - Returning Home

Following breakfast, we transfer to the airport with hearts full of gratitude and a renewed appreciation for those whose courage secured the freedoms we enjoy today. As we return home, we carry with us not only unforgettable memories of Europe's historic battlefields, but also a deeper understanding of the leadership, sacrifice, and unwavering determination that shaped the course of modern history. DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A deposit of \$300.00 per person is required to reserve space on the tour. An additional payment of \$1500.00 per person is due April 10, 2027. The final payment is due no less than 90 days prior to the departure date of the tour (June 5, 2027). Deposits may be made by personal check, money order, or credit card (Visa/MC/Discover). Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for an additional 3% non-refundable fee.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels their tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00) per person up until 91 days before departure. For cancellations 90-74 days before departure the cancellation fee will be \$300.00 per person. For cancellations 74-57 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 75% of the tour cost. There will be no refund for cancellations within 56 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to Templeton Tours in writing. **Trip insurance is recommended.**

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip air transportation from Charlotte, NC (CLT). Nine (9) nights hotel accommodations. Meals as detailed in the itinerary, and meals customarily served on overseas flights.
