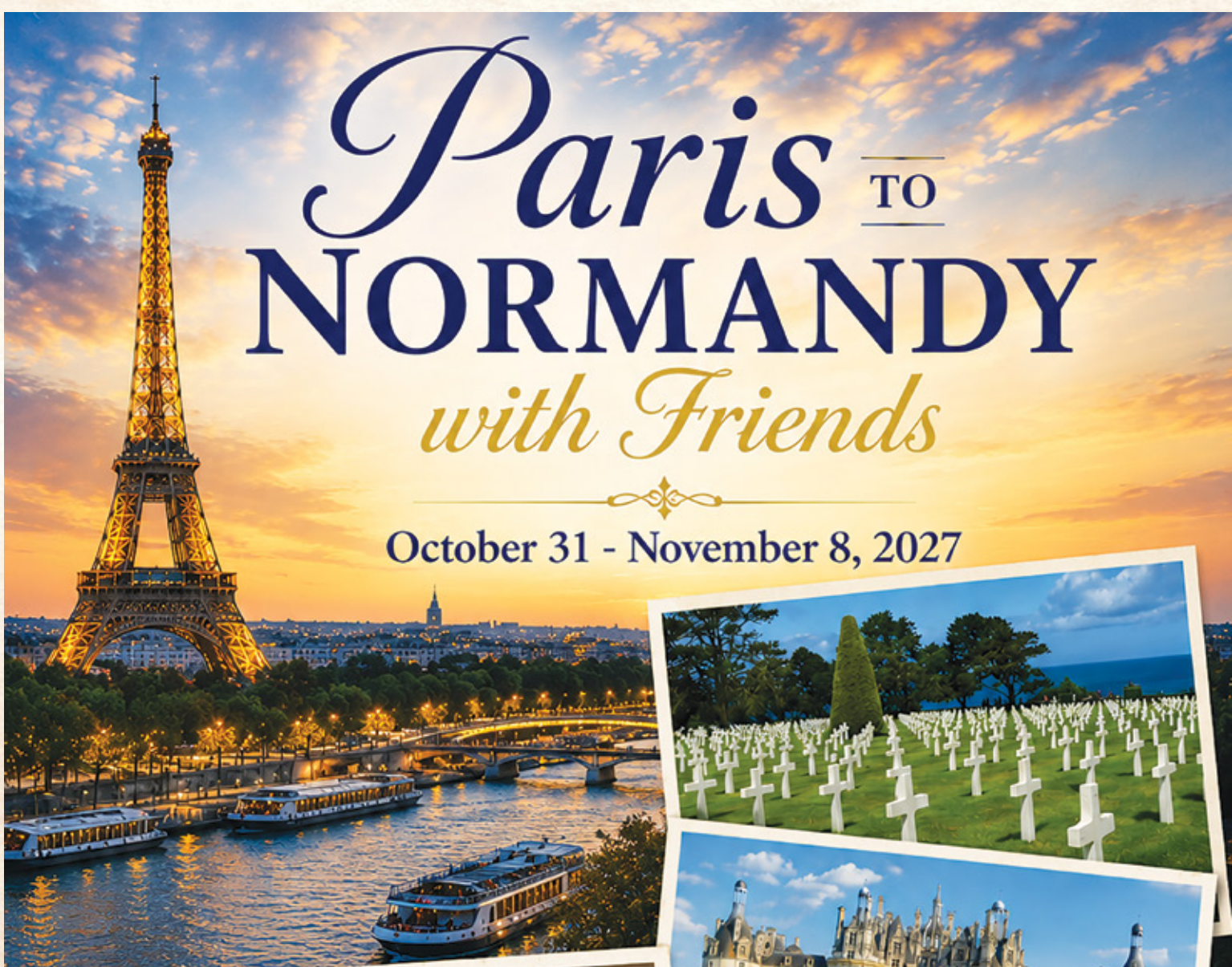

Today we depart the USA for a European adventure in France. Our overnight flight to Paris will include meals as we make our way over the Atlantic Ocean.

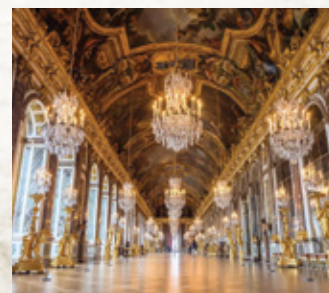
November 1st – Arrive in Paris: Welcome to the City of Light

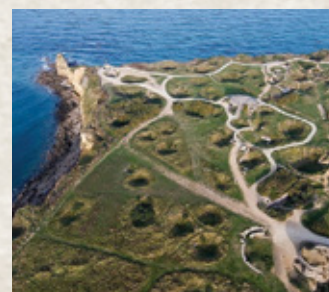
November 2nd – Paris & Versailles: Royal Splendor and Paris by Night

Today we discover why Paris has long been considered one of the world's great capitals. Our panoramic city tour introduces many of the landmarks that have become symbols of France, including the Arc de Triomphe, the Champs-Élysées, Place de la Concorde, the Latin Quarter, Montparnasse, and, of course, the magnificent Eiffel Tower. This afternoon you will have free-time to explore Paris on your own, or take an optional tour to the Palace of Versailles, the spectacular palace of Louis XIV (\$99). Walking through the lavish State Apartments, the Royal Bedroom, and the breathtaking Hall of Mirrors, we'll experience the incredible wealth and artistic achievement of France's royal age. Stroll through André Le Nôtre's magnificent gardens before returning to Paris. As evening falls, we enjoy one of the highlights of our tour—a dinner cruise along the Seine River. Illuminated monuments, graceful bridges, and the sparkling Eiffel Tower remind us why Paris is forever known as the “City of Light.” Overnight: Paris (B/D)



November 3rd – Normandy: Where Heroes Changed History

Today we journey into Normandy, where one of history's greatest military operations unfolded. Standing atop the cliffs of Pointe du Hoc, we'll witness the dramatic landscape where U.S. Army Rangers scaled sheer rock faces under enemy fire on D-Day. We continue to Sainte-Mère-Église, forever remembered for the heroic American airborne landings that marked the opening hours of Operation Overlord. Our visit to the Airborne Museum vividly tells the story of the courageous soldiers of the 82nd and 101st Airborne Divisions whose sacrifice helped secure freedom for Europe. This is a day of gratitude, remembrance, and profound appreciation for the courage of the Greatest Generation. Overnight: Normandy (B/D)

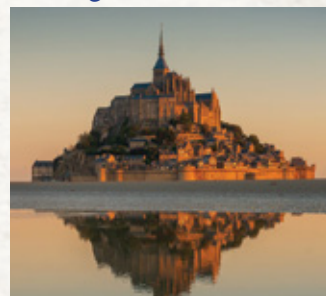


November 4th – Bayeux & Mont Saint-Michel: Medieval France

The morning begins at the Normandy American Cemetery overlooking Omaha Beach. Row upon row of white marble crosses and Stars of David create one of



the most moving memorials in the world. Here we pause to honor those who gave the ultimate sacrifice for freedom. We continue to charming Bayeux, where half-timbered buildings, winding streets, and the magnificent Gothic cathedral transport us back through the centuries. Later, one of France's most breathtaking sights comes into view—Mont Saint-Michel. Rising dramatically from the sea, this UNESCO World Heritage Site has inspired pilgrims and travelers for over one thousand years. Crossing the causeway, we'll explore its medieval streets before ascending to the magnificent Benedictine Abbey overlooking the surrounding tidal flats. By evening we arrive in the beautiful walled city of Saint-Malo. Overnight: St. Malo (B)



November 5th – Tours & Loire Valley: Castles, Kings & Countryside

Leaving the Normandy coast, we travel into the enchanting Loire Valley, often called the “Garden of France.” Our first stop is Angers, home to the imposing Château d’Angers, whose massive medieval walls have guarded the city for more than seven centuries. The scenic countryside unfolds before us as vineyards, rolling hills, and picturesque villages accompany our drive toward Tours, the perfect base for exploring one of Europe’s most celebrated regions. Overnight: Tours (B/D)



November 6th – The Châteaux of the Loire: Living Like Royalty

Today is devoted to two of France's most magnificent castles. We first visit elegant Château de Chenonceau, perhaps the most beautiful château in France. Gracefully spanning the River Cher, its stunning architecture and magnificent gardens have earned it the title “The Ladies’ Château.” Next we travel to Amboise, where Renaissance kings ruled and Leonardo da Vinci spent the final years of his extraordinary life. Touring the Royal Château of Amboise, we'll discover the remarkable influence of the French Renaissance. This evening provides a uniquely French experience as we participate in a hands-on cooking class led by a local chef. Together we'll prepare and enjoy a delicious three-course meal inspired by regional cuisine. Overnight: Tours (B/D)



November 7th – Chartres & Return to Paris: Faith & Architecture

Our final touring day begins with views of magnificent Château de Chambord, the largest château in the Loire Valley and one of France's architectural masterpieces. We then continue to Chartres, home to one of the finest Gothic cathedrals ever constructed. For centuries pilgrims have journeyed here to admire its soaring architecture, extraordinary stained-glass windows, and the treasured relic known as the Veil of the Virgin. Returning to Paris, enjoy some final free time before we gather for our Farewell Dinner, celebrating wonderful memories, new friendships, and an unforgettable week discovering the beauty and heritage of France. GENERAL CONDITIONS

DEPOSITS AND PAYMENTS: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required to make a reservation. An additional payment of \$1500.00 per person is due April 16, 2027. The final payment is due July 23, 2027. Payment can be made by personal check or money order. Credit card payments beyond the initial deposit will be accepted for a non-refundable fee of 3%. Reservations received after September 25, 2026 may incur additional charges due to supplier contract terms.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: If a passenger cancels his/her tour membership there will be a cancellation fee of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) per person up until 100 days before departure. For cancellations from 99 - 65 days before departure the cancellation fee will be 50% of the tour price. There will be no refund for cancellations within 64 days of departure, no-shows, or partially completed tours. All cancellation requests must be addressed to TEMPLETON TOURS INC. in writing.

FARE INCLUSIVE: Roundtrip Air Transportation from Nashville, TN (BNA). Seven (7) nights hotel accommodations, based on two people sharing a double or twin-bedded room in first class hotels. 12 Meals: consisting of 7 breakfasts, 5 table d'hôte dinners (D). Airport-hotel transfers in Paris for passengers flying on group flights. Sightseeing by private motorcoaches, utilizing the services of a local licensed English speaking guide. Entrance fees for select attractions. Group transfers between airports and hotels. Service charges and taxes normally levied by hotels and restaurants. Tips to guides, motorcoach drivers, hotel porters, and restaurant staff (i.e., maitre d', table waiter, etc.) are also included. The brochure price is per person in US dollars based on double occupancy.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport costs, Entry visa fees (if any), and health documentation costs (when required). lunches/dinners and food and beverages (including coffee and tea) not listed in the itinerary; any optional sightseeing tours and/or excursions; accident and baggage insurance; transporting and handling excess luggage; tips to persons rendering special personal services; items of a purely personal nature such as laundry, telephone, room service orders, etc.; transportation between the home city and the international departure city.

TOUR ITINERARY SUBJECT TO CHANGE: TTI strives to adhere to the printed itinerary; however, circumstances may necessitate changes without advance notice during the tour. TTI reserves the right to change the itinerary, and is not responsible for any changes caused by unforeseen circumstances beyond our control.

AIR ROUTINGS: The price includes IATA jet economy class transportation from the international departure city applicable on all IATA and ARC carriers, based on the 6/45 day Apex fare to Europe. TTI reserves the right to choose the air carrier, routing, and departure time for each passenger. Airfares used are based on contracted group fares and are highly restrictive. Payments for and restrictions on airline tickets are governed by the applicable fare. Cancellation fees levied by the airlines are applicable if you cancel or change your air ticket for any reason after purchase of air ticket. Ticketing must be completed 45 days prior to departure. Group fares do not permit deviations; passengers who wish to deviate may arrange their own airfare. An airline credit TBA will be given to those passengers who arrange their own airfare. Passengers planning to arrange their own air transportation must notify TTI in writing on or before July 1, 2027. Seat numbers are assigned by the airline at check-in; specific seat requests cannot be guaranteed. Passengers are responsible for providing frequent flyer information upon check-in.

HOTELS: Tour prices are land only, per person, based on two people sharing a room. Single rooms are subject to availability and at an additional cost of \$1595. (Tour participants without a roommate will be charged a single supplement surcharge.

CHANGE FEES: Changes to an existing reservation, whatever the cause, will incur a \$50 per person charge plus any additional supplier fees. This includes name spelling changes and rooming changes. Replacing a traveling passenger with another traveling passenger constitutes a cancellation, subject to cancellation penalties. Changes or additions after departure are subject to local rates at the time of amendment and must be paid directly by the passenger to the service provider. There are no refunds for unused services.

BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: One (1) piece of checked luggage whose overall dimensions do not exceed 62 inches (length + width + height) and whose weight does not exceed fifty (50) pounds in total. One (1) piece of carry-on luggage. Tips to hotel porters are included for one normal sized piece of luggage, excluding carry-on bags which must remain in your possession at all times. Regulations are subject to change without notice. Please read the monthly correspondence from TEMPLETON TOURS for the most current information. Dangerous articles such as firearms, explosives, oxygen, or combustible substances are prohibited in your luggage. Medications, valuables, passports, and a change of clothing should be packed in your carry-on bag.

DISABILITIES: Due to the amount of walking at the sites we will visit, persons requiring oxygen or oxygen therapy will not be permitted on the tour. For reasons of passenger safety and well-being, persons with impaired mobility, vision, or mental capacity will not be permitted on the tour. TEMPLETON TOURS, INC. reserves the right to refuse passage to anyone who is in such physical or mental condition as to be unfit for travel or who may require care and attention beyond which we can provide. The tour requires a substantial amount of walking and many of the sites are not accessible by wheelchair.

INSURANCE: Acting only as agents for suppliers, TEMPLETON TOURS is not responsible for flight delays or missed connections, damage, loss, or theft of luggage and/or personal belongings, or for personal injury, accident, illness and/or death as a result of any occurrences or conditions beyond its control, including, but not limited to, defects in vehicles, breakdown in equipment, strikes, terrorist attacks, hostage situations, kidnappings, hijackings, protests, riots, public demonstrations, inclement weather, or theft. For your protection, **we highly recommend that you purchase travel insurance** to cover these possibilities. Information will be provided with your tour confirmation.

PASSPORT: Each tour member is required to present a valid passport with an expiration date of **May 9, 2028** or later. Complete instructions and application forms for passports can be obtained by contacting your local courthouse or post office. Your Name on the Registration Form must match your name as it appears on your Passport.

PRICE CHANGES: Tour conditions and air fares are subject to Governmental, IATA, ARC, and airline regulation requirements in effect at the date of and during the tour. All rates are quoted in US dollars and are subject to change without notice. Taxes and fuel surcharges are included in your tour cost and are subject to change without notice. Templeton Tours reserves the right to pass along fuel surcharges or additional taxes imposed.

TOUR CANCELLATION: TTI reserves the right to cancel or withdraw the tour at any time. In the event of a cancellation deemed necessary by TTI, the sole and exclusive responsibility of TEMPLETON TOURS is to refund all monies recovered.
