Spend a spectacular day among the Florida Keys' pristine waterscape, as you cruise by boat to offshore mangrove islands for a stand-up paddleboard trip that leads to a shallow sandbar perfect for swimming and relaxing. Join a small group of six adventure seekers at the dock, where a local professional boat captain will welcome you aboard a spacious pontoon boat. Breathe in the salty air as you cast away from Key West on an offshore route, hopefully glimpsing sharks, turtles and dolphins swimming alongside the boat. You'll then anchor near a collection of tiny mangrove islands and head out on a stand-up paddleboard to explore Key West's aquatic wonderland. Lesson provided. Feel the freedom of paddling through winding tunnels of spindly mangrove roots, where iguanas, tropical fish, and seabirds all live among the ocean environment. Don't want to paddle, relax and enjoy the quiet on the boat. Your captain will then steer the boat to a nearby sandbar where you can unwind like a local with sand chairs that plop right into the water, shady umbrellas that shelter you from sun, tasty snacks served on board, plus the option to walk along salt flats or swim in crystal-clear blue waters off the fabulous Florida Keys. If tide is high, beach on a deserted island will be substituted.

- Tour departure times are local. Please check your tickets for your meeting location and time. Allow time for the tender ride in the case that your tour meets on the pier. Departure times are subject to change at any time, but you will be notified in advance by the Shore Excursions staff.
- Most tours operate rain or shine. If your tour is cancelled because of weather, your onboard SeaPass® account will be fully refunded.
- Once you purchase your shore excursion online, you will receive a confirmation via e-mail. After you board your ship for your cruise, your excursion tickets will be delivered to your stateroom. Again, please verify meeting time and location as some tours meet in a lounge area on the ship and some at the pier.
- If you wish to cancel your tour prior to the sailing, you can do so online up to 2 days prior to the sail date. Your credit card will be automatically refunded.

Booking Onboard

There are three ways to book your excursions onboard the ship:

- Visit the Shore Excursions desk
- Fill out the order form in your stateroom
- Use the Interactive TV system, available on most ships

The cost of the excursion will be charged to your SeaPass® account, for which you will be registered when you check in online or at the pier, prior to boarding the ship. All tour purchases will be reflected on your SeaPass® account.

Tour Pricing:

Shore Excursions are priced per person in the specific country’s local currency. Although most tours provide transportation and a local guide, many destinations also have private transportations for customized tours. Please check the tour description for amenities such as food, drinks and entrance fees. If you decide to leave or deviate from the tour at any time, you will be responsible for the cost to get back on board the ship including any other unrelated expenses. You will not receive a refund for any services that are not utilized.

Gratuities:

Tour pricing does not include gratuity unless specified. Extending a gratuity to your guide and/or driver is strictly optional; however in some countries, your guide may anticipate that if you are pleased with their services, you will reward them in a monetary fashion. Generally, an appropriate tip would be \$4-\$6 USD per person for a half day tour and \$10-\$15 USD per person for a full day tour.

Currency:

For your convenience, currency exchange rates are updated periodically so you can calculate pricing. The purchase of an excursion is charged in the same currency you paid for your cruise. Online cancellations will be returned to the credit card used and onboard refunds will be returned to your SeaPass® account in USD.

Price Changes:

Prices can change at any time and can vary by sail date and cruise. The prices in this brochure are valid for the sail date and cruise at the time the brochure was created and are subject to availability. Children on Shore Excursions:

A parent or guardian must accompany all guests under 18 years of age. Children's tickets are available for many tours and pricing for these will vary according to their age. Please refer to pricing scale below
